- **03:40** Northern Cardinal song begins, Japanese White-eye calls continue.
- **03:58** Zebra Dove calls (Morse code-like sequence), remaining in background.
- **04:00** Common Myna loud calls begin.
- **04:37** Loud Common Myna calls again.
- 04:55 Loud Zebra Dove calls begin.

[Mix of Northern Cardinal, Japanese White-eye and Common Myna continues for several minutes.]

- 07:18 Apapane song begins.
- 07:34 Apapane wing flutter sounds, now heard repeatedly as Apapanes fly over.
- 08:35 Spotted Dove calls, behind louder Apapanes.

08:49 louder Zebra Dove calls begin, with multiple doves calling together with sporadic Japanese White-eye calls, Northern Cardinal song and Common Myna calls.

- **10:40** Multiple Common Mynas chorusing loudly, Zebra Doves too.
- **11:50** Sputtering calls of Kalij Pheasant, which go on for minutes.
- **11:57** Hwamei calls and song, loud Northern Cardinal song a bit later.
- 12:40 Louder Hwamei song, also at 13:00.
- 14:00-14:04, and later: Gray Francolin(s) crowing.
- **14:19** Gray Francolin short calls and crowing.
- **14:40** Loud Northern Cardinal song begins.
- 14:52 Loud Zebra Doves, Common Mynas.
- **15:30** Japanese White-eye in background.
- 15:50 25:00 Gray Francolin crows as Northern Cardinal sings in foreground for several minutes; Zebra Doves continue in background to at least 24:00, and Common Mynas continue and dominate sounds in last several minutes of recording; occasional Spotted Dove song/call in background.
