- 2:12** Horned Lark high-pitched song (very soft).
- 2:20** Grasshopper Sparrow trilled song.
- 3:54** Meadowlark song starts, soft.
- 4:33** Meadowlark song louder, along with rattled calls.
- 6:08** Common Nighthawk vocal call and male wing boom sounds begin.
- 6:12** Vesper Sparrow trilled song in background. Common Yellowthroat song. Black-billed Magpie call.
- 6:21** Greater Sage-Grouse calls begin; louder at 7:30.
- 6:23** American Bittern (Common Yellowthroat noted above and American Bittern signal adjacent marsh habitat), again at 6:47.
- 6:24** Lark Bunting
- 6:30** Birdsong medley, including Horned Lark, Common Nighthawk and Greater Sage-Grouse, Vesper Sparrow, Western Meadowlark, Common Yellowthroat, Ring-necked Pheasant, and Mourning Dove.
- 8:06** Loud Horned Lark starts and runs to 9:22.
- 9:27** Vesper Sparrow sings until 10:20.
- 10:33** Loud Western Meadowlark.
- 10:44** Coyotes add voices to mix.
- 12:00** Mourning Dove.
- 12:37** American Bittern.
- 14:52** Grasshopper's staccato wing sounds.
- 14:59** Horned Lark. Continues to 16:08.
- 16:34** An American Robin, until 17:50.
- 18:15** Lark Bunting.
- 21:58** A Sora trills once.
- 23:38** A Savannah Sparrow sings a couple of times.
- 25:58** END
